

REQUIREMENTS & PREFERENCES FOR REPUBLIC COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS

Amos & Joyce Blecha 4-H Scholarship – Due by February 15

MUST apply thru the Republic Co Community Foundation website (<http://republiccountycf.org>)

Student in good standing qualifying for graduation from a Republic County high school

- Student who will be enrolling in post-secondary education or vocational school
 - Involved in extracurricular activities
- First consideration given to current 4-H members who have been involved in 4-H for at least three years
- Selection committee will be the Republic County 4-H Scholarship committee with input from the family at their request

Requirements for the following four local Republic Co 4-H Scholarships

Must fill out the Republic Co Senior Scholarship Form (2 pages)

Type a One-page Essay - “How 4-H Impacted Me”

Hand in your 4-H Record Book to the Extension Office by March 15th

Republic County 4-H Scholarship

- Must be a current 4-H member of Republic Co. who is enrolling in post-secondary education
- The Republic County 4-H Scholarship committee will choose the recipients

John E. Anderson Memorial 4-H Scholarship - \$500 Scholarship

- Must be a to current or member who was active when graduation from high school
 - \ now beginning or transferring to KSU Manhattan from another university
- Preference given to a student with planned major in the field of Agriculture (specifically, Agronomy)
- The Republic County 4-H Scholarship committee will choose the recipient

Eugene Wiche 4-H Scholarship

- Must be a current 4-H member of Republic County
- Must fill out Republic Co 4-H Scholarship requirements
- Must also include **additional essay** – “*How I will pay for College*”
- Selection will be based on 50% 4-H Leadership and 50% Financial need

Dr. Wirt R. Barnard 4-H Scholarship - Renewable Scholarship

This is a renewable scholarship with \$1,000 for the first (Freshman) year and \$1000 each for Sophomore, Junior & Senior years, if a grade point average of 2.5 is maintained

- Must be pre-enrolled at Kansas State University in any curriculum
 - Must be a Republic County student who is currently active in 4-H
 - Must submit your 4-H Record Book along with your application
 - Selection is based on a 4-H member who best exemplifies outstanding leadership
 - Knowledge of Dr. Wirt R. Barnard is helpful
